QUEEN MARY 2

When Cunard Line's *Queen Mary 2* debuted in 2004, this 2,620-passenger ship became the largest, longest, widest, tallest and most expensive passenger vessel ever constructed. The *QM2* stretches nearly four football fields in length – 147 feet longer than the Eiffel Tower is tall – and towers 200 feet above the waterline, equal to the height of a 23-story building.

In the spirit of great trans-Atlantic liners such as *Queen Elizabeth 2*, *Normandie* and *Ile de France*, the *QM2* evokes a feeling of grandeur and elegance, while at the same time featuring contemporary style and amenities and the latest technological innovations. Cunard's first ocean liner since *QE2*, she features classic hallmarks such as sweeping staircases, expansive promenade, stylish restaurants and public rooms of an imposing scale.
