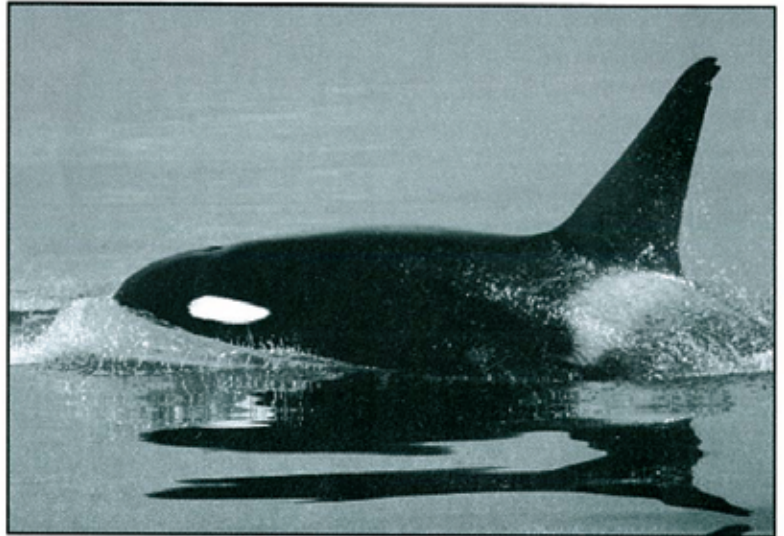

Terms and Conditions

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office. A non-refundable deposit of \$630 per person is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due April 29. Bookings made after April 29 will require full payment at time of booking. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

90 days or more prior	Deposit non-refundable
89 to 60 days prior	50% non-refundable
59 to 30 days prior	75% non-refundable
29 to 0 days prior	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.

Prices: All prices in this brochure are in Canadian dollars, unless otherwise stated, are based on October 15, 2008 contract rates, and are subject to change should currencies fluctuate or surcharge be imposed.
