

International Driving Permits (IDP)

If your travel plans include driving in foreign lands, remember that CAA is the sole issuing authority in Canada for an IDP. An IDP is valid almost anywhere in the world and is required to operate a motor vehicle in many foreign countries (car rental companies around the world require IDPs to be shown by renters). All you need is a valid Canadian driver's licence and two recent passport photos. IDPs are issued while you wait, for a fee.

CAA Niagara's Car Care Centre "Hunter B400" is a state-of-the-art device that performs a complete brake, suspension and alignment test in just three minutes. The first of its kind in Canada, the B400 test, offered FREE to CAA Niagara Members annually, can be complemented with a visual inspection to ensure the underside of your vehicle is at peak performance.

At Your Service

Conveniently located at 363 Lake Street, just north of the QEW in St. Catharines, CAA Car Care Centre provides a full menu of maintenance and light repairs, including oil and filter service, batteries, brakes, tire sales and service, engine performance services, cooling systems, electrical systems, shocks, struts and suspension, inspections and safety checks.

Approved Auto Repair Services

CAA endorses select auto service outlets after they have passed rigorous examinations by qualified inspectors. Only after meeting these stringent conditions are they allowed to display the Approved Auto Repair Service (AARS) sign. Approved garages provide Members with AARS one year/20,000 km warranty on all work performed. In the event of a dispute over price or service, the AARS facility has agreed to let CAA be the final arbitrator. For a list of AARS garages in the Niagara Region, visit www.caa.niagara.net.

Your Membership Menu

CAA Niagara has developed a menu of Membership programs designed to provide just the right level and kind of roadside service.

Basic Membership

The CAA Basic Membership is an introductory level of Membership. While it provides access to our famous roadside assistance, as well as numerous travel, insurance, financial and personal protection services and benefits, it is designed for those who drive shorter distances. Primary Members are entitled to six roadside service calls per year with up to 10 km of towing per call.

Plus Membership

A CAA Plus Membership is our enhanced Membership designed to increase some of the benefits of the Basic Membership. It is recommended for medium or high mileage drivers, frequent travellers or owners of special interest automobiles and motorcycles. Four of six annual roadside service calls qualify for up to 250 km of free towing from the point of breakdown to the repair facility of your choice.

48-hour waiting period applies.

Plus RV Membership

CAA Plus RV extends CAA Plus services to dual wheel campers/motor homes and dual wheel pick-ups with trailers.

You must be a CAA Plus Member to be eligible for this program. 48-hour waiting period applies.

Associate Membership

Associate Membership is extended to all family members in the same household as a Primary Member. Associates need only show proof of living under the same roof as the Primary Member (i.e. drivers licence). Associate Members are entitled to 4 road service calls per year.

Upgrading Your CAA Coverage

To upgrade your current CAA Membership or add a Member, visit or call your local CAA Niagara office. See back cover. A waiting period does apply.

Membership Cards

CAA Members receive a Membership card that corresponds to their level of coverage. Cards are valid for the next three years, though the Membership is still renewed annually. Members automatically receive a renewal notice before their Membership expiry date. Prompt Membership renewal ensures no interruption in service. Your card should be handy at all times to take advantage of the many valuable savings opportunities. For more information on these programs, look in the Member Rewards section of this handbook.

Member Protection



Legal Defence Benefits

If you're charged with a traffic offence anywhere in the world, CAA will reimburse basic Members up to \$50 for legal fees and Plus Members up to \$100. Coverage is for Members who believe they were unjustly charged and enter a not guilty plea in court. Excluded violations: parking offences, while driving under the influence of alcohol, drugs or narcotics under the Criminal Code. Violations incurred while driving a commercial vehicle are not covered. Receipts must be submitted within 60 days of the court date and Members must be and remain in good standing at the time of the violation and court date.

Valid once per Membership year.

Emergency Cheque Cashing

Members in good standing, who find themselves stranded without cash more than 80 km (50 miles) from home, may cash a personal cheque for up to \$100 at most CAA/AAA affiliated offices in Canada or the US. Just present your Membership card and other required photo identification. (Limits apply)

Trip Accident Assistance

If you are involved in a reportable motor vehicle collision more than 160 km (100 miles) away from home, we will reimburse you for unforeseen expenses resulting from that accident up to a limit of \$300 for Basic Members and \$500 for Plus Members. This benefit applies for up to 72 hours after the accident and covers ONE of the following: rental car (from a licensed car rental agency), or local lodging and meals, or commercial transportation to your destination or home. Receipts are required for expenses to be claimed, as well as a copy of the police insurance report. The Member must be driving at the time of the accident.

Travel Accident Insurance

When purchasing airline tickets through CAA Travel, Members automatically receive \$100,000 travel accident insurance.

Plus Members receive \$500,000 insurance.

Arrest Bond/Bail Bond

CAA Niagara guarantees the appearance of its Member in court, when required, up to the expiry date on the Membership card. The CAA Membership card can be accepted against an arrest bond, up to \$5,000 to secure a bail bond, for any traffic violation excluding violations: involving driving while under the influence of alcohol, drugs or narcotics, failure to appear for violations, driving on a suspended/revoked driver's licence, hit and run, failure to present evidence of insurance, illegal use or falsification of licence or registration, engaging in a felony, attempting to elude police, or while driving a vehicle used for commercial purposes.

Theft and Hit-and-Run Rewards

A reward of \$500 is offered to any person who provides information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person who steals a Member's car, boat (excluding outboard motor), or snowmobile, or of a hit-and-run driver who causes personal injury to a Member (police, vehicle owner(s) and immediate family are excluded from the reward).

Member Advocacy

From distracted driving to better roads, CAA works on behalf of its Members at all levels of Government. CAA is also an active supporter of several community services.

Emergency Road Service



Emergency Road Service is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week and is designed to assist you in an emergency when the vehicle you are either driving or riding in becomes disabled. Your Membership coverage applies to you and applies to those emergency and towing services listed in this booklet. Please take a few minutes to acquaint yourself with the Emergency Road Service (ERS) provided by CAA Niagara.

For faster service, please have the following information available:

- CAA Membership number and expiration date
- Year, make and model of vehicle
- Plate number and province
- Location of vehicle and problem with vehicle
- Phone number from where you are calling

Driver's licence and membership card must be presented to CAA service operator for service to be rendered.

You must remain at or near the vehicle to receive service. If the problem is resolved before the service operator arrives, please notify CAA immediately to cancel the request, as each service call is charged to the Club and against your record, whether or not completed.

Always call CAA first to ensure that the nearest available service vehicle is dispatched for assistance. Do not call a local garage or towing company unless CAA service is unavailable, otherwise full reimbursement of service delivery costs may not be possible.

With your Membership, Emergency Road Service will be provided without charge to the nearest available CAA contract facility. Your service call will include a trip to the disabled vehicle and reasonable amount of time at the scene to make your vehicle operable.

We select Emergency Road Service facilities for their ability to handle service calls, but we cannot guarantee that these facilities will always have the parts and equipment to make repairs.

When your vehicle cannot be made operable by providing the services listed in the brochure, CAA/AAA will assist you in finding the nearest open place of repair. If a repair facility cannot be located, CAA/AAA will assist you in obtaining lodging or alternative transportation, which will be at your own expense.

Charges for service that exceed the benefits listed will be at the prevailing hourly or mileage rate of the region where service is provided.

For your protection, service cannot be provided to unattended vehicles.

At your request and at your cost, the club will, if appropriate, arrange for you to be transported back to your disabled vehicle and transported after service has been rendered.

During severe weather conditions, civil disturbances or national emergencies, service may be temporarily suspended.

In most areas, Emergency Road Service facilities are independent businesses and are not employees of the Canadian Automobile Association (CAA) or its affiliates. Responsibility for loss, damage or unsatisfactory workmanship remains with the facility providing the emergency road service.

Eligible Vehicles

Service applies to all properly licensed, plated, insured, four-wheeled, motor-driven passenger or recreational type vehicles(vans, campers and motorhomes). It applies only if those services can be safely delivered. Dealer plates and trip permits are eligible for Basic or Plus service, depending on level of Membership.

In instances when your vehicle becomes disabled while towing a light duty trailer, service will be provided for the trailer. You may be required to pay for trailer towing. Fifth-wheel trailer requires CAA Plus RV coverage.

Dual wheel campers/motorhomes are eligible for all services except towing, extrication/winching and tire service. Dual wheel unloaded pickup trucks are eligible for all services except tire service. Rented passenger vehicles and commercial vehicles are eligible for service. Taxis, limousines, commercial cubed vans and dual wheeled commercial cubed vans are not eligible under any CAA policy.

Plus RV Membership is designed for recreational type vehicles and is required when the applicable "vehicular unit" has more than four wheels. Vehicle definitions:

Motorized RVs: A recreational vehicle driven under its power and is not towed behind another vehicle.

Dual Wheel Trucks: Any truck with more than four wheels, provided the truck is classified as an RV, meaning that it must be of the passenger, pleasure or recreational type.

Fifth Wheels: Trailers towed by trucks with a fifth wheel hitch.

Trailers: Trailers pulled on a ball type hitch (i.e. boat, motorcycle, horse, snowmobile, utility, travel, hardtop or tent trailers)

Bus Conversions: School buses or coach-type buses converted into recreational vehicles.

Van Conversions: Vans converted to include a sink, stove, bed or fridge.

Truck and Slide-In Camper: Typically a pick-up truck with camper unit affixed. RV coverage applies when both units are being towed or if truck has six wheels.

Emergency Service

The following emergency services will be provided to place your vehicle in a driveable condition. If these attempts are unsuccessful after a reasonable effort by the service provider, the towing service provision will apply.

Flat Tire

If your vehicle's spare is inflated and serviceable, it will be installed to replace a flat tire. If no inflated spare is available, the vehicle will be towed in accordance with the towing provision. CAA Plus RV provides for the replacing of the flat tire with the vehicle's mounted spare.



Battery Boost & Battery Replacement

A battery boost will be provided in an attempt to start your vehicle. If the vehicle cannot be started within a reasonable amount of time the towing provisions will apply.

CAA Niagara also operates a Battery Express program, designed to get you on the go when your battery lets you down.



This service can be requested by calling 905-684-4396. We'll test your old battery and, if necessary, you can purchase a new CAA branded battery with a 3-year warranty, right on the spot. We will install your new battery and dispose of your old one in a safe, environmentally sensitive manner. CAA Member discounts apply.

Fuel Delivery

A limited supply of fuel will be delivered to your disabled vehicle to enable you to reach the nearest open service station or your vehicle

will be towed in accordance with the towing provisions, listed below, to a facility where fuel is available. Specific brands or octane ratings cannot be promised. The cost of the fuel will be based on pump prices current at the time of delivery. CAA Plus and CAA Plus RV Members receive the fuel free of charge.

Mechanical Adjustments

Minor/temporary adjustments, not requiring parts or supplies, will be made in an attempt to enable your vehicle to operate safely under its own power. If the vehicle cannot be placed in safe driving condition, the towing provisions will apply.

Lockout Service



If your keys are locked inside the vehicle, a service provider will be sent to gain entrance. If your keys are lost, broken or the service provider cannot gain entrance to your vehicle, locksmith service or reimbursement for locksmith service up to \$50 will be provided. In cases where the vehicle cannot be made operable, towing service will be provided in accordance with CAA Niagara towing provision. CAA Plus Members receive up to \$100 for work needed to make the vehicle operable.



Extricating/Winching

Your vehicle will be extricated/winched when it can be safely reached from a normally travelled or established thoroughfare. If special equipment, additional manpower or vehicles are required, the associated costs may be at your expense. CAA Plus Members are covered for a second vehicle and operator for up to one hour at the scene.

Towing Service

When your vehicle cannot be safely driven after attempting any of the listed emergency services, your vehicle will be towed to the ERS facility rendering the service or a repair facility en route, or 10 km in any direction from the point of disablement at no charge. CAA Plus Members will be towed to a repair facility of your choice up to 250 km in any direction from the point of disablement.

Emergency Repair Cheque Acceptance

Your personal cheque for up to \$400 will be accepted by any independent contract facility providing emergency services or repairs for CAA Members. A valid Membership card must be presented at the time of payment. Only a personalized cheque matching your Membership card will be accepted.

Emergency Road Service Limitations

CAA road service is intended to help Members with common emergency problems for which we can provide assistance. For this reason, CAA does not provide:

- Service to loaded or altered vehicles where the provision of the service may jeopardize the load or damage the vehicle.
- Service to unattended vehicles unless pre-authorized by CAA.
- Services that may be chargeable to an insurance company as the result of a fire, theft or vandalism.
- Collision towing, where the policy of an insurance company owned by a provincial Crown Corporation operating exclusively within a province pre-empts CAA service.
- Second or additional trips by the service person on any one call, including re-tows from residence to repair facility.
- Service to a vehicle that: is abandoned or stolen; is to be towed to a salvage yard; has failed a safety inspection; is impounded due to a legal infraction; unplated, or unlicensed.

- Service to a vehicle willfully driven into an area not regularly travelled, eg. vacant lot, open fields, beaches, impassable private or recreational roads, yards, mud or snow filled driveways or alleys(service persons will not shovel snow), construction sites or other locations that cannot be reached safely.
- Service to school buses and vehicles for hire, identified as taxis and limousines.
- Impound and storage fees due to towing as a result of infractions of local ordinances or laws.
- Cost of parts, labour and repairs.
- Accepting appointments for service calls.

Alternate Service

If you have followed the procedure outlined to obtain Emergency Road Service, and CAA service is not available, you may obtain your own service; pay for it and submit the original receipt to your Club within 30 days. Reimbursement will be based on the prevailing commercial rate for the region where the vehicle was disabled. When CAA service was available but alternative service was obtained, reimbursements will be based on the Club contract rate for the area where the disablement occurred. In instances where CAA contractor access is legally restricted (toll roads, limited access highways), full reimbursement will be provided for covered services. This applies to all Membership levels.

Emergency Road Service Maximums

To ensure fair and efficient service to all Members, CAA has reasonable limitations and regulations as set forth by its officers and directors acting in the interest of all Members whose Membership dues pay for all services. Emergency Road Service benefits will be suspended to Primary Members who exceed six Emergency Road Service calls during a Membership year and to Associate Members who exceed four Emergency Road Service calls per Membership year. Members who reach these limits will be offered service at a special rate; the Member will be required to pay at the time of service.

All CAA Plus or CAA Plus RV Emergency Road Service is suspended when a Member surpasses his or her Emergency Road Service call allotment for the remainder of the Membership year. Upon renewal of Membership, full services are reinstated.





Additional Information

Money Back Guarantee

Under certain conditions, there is a money back guarantee if you are not satisfied with our services during the first 30 days of your new Membership. If you have any questions or require assistance in any Membership matter, please contact your nearest CAA office. Note: Enrollment fee is non-refundable.

Refund Policy

All requests for Membership refunds must be made in writing and include your Membership card. All cancellations are subject to an administration fee up to \$20.

Moving or Transferring Out of Territory

Members moving out of CAA Niagara's territory (the Regional Municipality of Niagara) should notify the club of their new address. Niagara Memberships remain active until renewal date when they are transferred to the member's new club. CAA will notify your new CAA/AAA Club so they can contact you to renew your membership.

Changes To Your Membership

All changes to your Membership such as name, address and phone number can be made to our membership services representatives directly by mail, telephone or in person at any of our branch offices.

Membership Renewals

You will automatically receive a renewal notice before your Membership expiry date. Prompt renewal ensures there is no interruption in service. When a Member does not renew his/her Membership by the expiry date, the Membership is considered to be lapsed and service can only be provided upon renewal of that Membership. This applies to the entire range of CAA services. Membership can be renewed using a major credit card online at our website www.caa.niagara.net, at major bank websites, by telephone banking, by credit card over the phone or by cheque, cash or debit in person. Past due renewals are subject to an enrollment fee.

Express Renewal

Get \$5 off your Membership fees just by joining Express Renewal. Use your credit card and never run the risk of being without CAA's safety, security and Member savings. Your Membership dues will automatically be applied to your major credit card.

If your CAA card is lost or stolen, you can obtain another card by calling any of our local offices. At that time, we will process a request for your new card and it will be mailed directly to your home.
